Penelitian ini dilatar belakangi sejak adanya pandemi *Covid-19*, peraturan pemerintah mengalami perubahan pada beberapa poin atau yang disebut dengan regulasi, terutama pada aspek pernikahan. Tujuan penelitian ini yakni mengetahui persepsi calon pengantin terhadap regulasi pernikahan pada pandemi *Covid-19* di Kecamatan Sukolilo. Pendekatan pada penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif deskriptif. Sumber dan teknik pengumpulan data yang digunakan ialah wawancara kepada pegawai KUA, dan pemberian angket *online* kepada calon pengantin yang mendaftarkan pernikahan di KUA Kecamatan Sukolilo. Hasil angket akan dianalisis menggunakan teknik statistik deskriptif, dilanjutkan hasil wawancara dan deskripsi angket menggunakan analisis kualitatif. Hasil analisis dalam penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa regulasi pernikahan pada pandemi *Covid-19* disebabkan oleh tingkat penyebaran *Covid-19*. Calon pengantin yang mendaftarkan pernikahan menurun dibandingkan ketika sebelum pandemi *Covid-19*. Calon pengantin yang tetap melaksanakan pernikahan dengan mematuhi protokol kesehatan yang sesuai dengan peraturan pemerintah pusat maupun daerah.

This research is based on the background of the *Covid-19* pandemic, the government regulations have changed at several points or what are called regulations, especially in the aspect of marriage. The purpose of this study is to determine the future bride perceptions on marriage regulations in the *Covid-19* pandemic in Sukolilo District. The approach of this research used descriptive qualitative approach. Source and data collection techniques used were interviews with KUA employees, and giving online quissionnaires to future brides who registered marriage at KUA Sukolilo District. The results of quissionnaire will be analyzed using descriptive statistical techniques, followed by the results of interviews and quissionnaire descriptions using qualitative analysis. The results of the analysis in this study shown that the regulation of marriage in the *Covid-19* pandemic is caused by the level of the spread of *Covid-19*. The future bride registering marriages has decreased compared to before the *Covid-19* pandemic. The future bride who continue to carry out marriages by complying with health protocols in accordance with central and local government regulations.
