And then I get anxiety about getting anxiety and then I get anxiety about throwing up because of my anxiety and then I throw up. I just feel so embarrassed about it and I don't. It's like how do you say to somebody like "Excuse me, I have to go throw up know because I'm anxious and scared and worried about". Literally no idea what I'm scared about but I'm gonna go throw up. See you guys. Um, yeah.

04:53-05:37: So I don't remember throwing up at school when I was in middle school because of anxiety, but I did throw up quite often in high school. From panic attacks I remember the first time, I think this might have been the first time. There were so many times. I just really the first and the last. But the first time was my freshman year. I throw up in homeroom because I met a new boy the I liked. And It triggered my social anxiety. And just my anxiety was heightened because I was in school and I was around people. And when I feel like I'm having panic attack and I'm around other people, my anxiety about throwing up goes up because I don't want in front of other people like who really does. And I do trying to talk to people about it, but I get responses this happens all the time. And people really do try to help or just like to be a voice of reason for me, and just be like trying to call me and center me and be like hey, like it's okay.

- 06:35-07:08: Okay. It's been 16 minutes. Let's unravel this and see how it's looking so far. I am so nervous coz I can see my hair right here. Oh God! I think I just bleach my chair. Oh, well! Holy crap old on. Wait! Okay. Okay, we're gonna we're gonna wash this off because I think it's good and I don't want my hair to fall off. What if this is one of those videos with like my hair falls off.

- 07:10-07:31: So I definitely should have left this in for a lot longer. I just got, I got so scared. I've never done this before. It is not blonde at all really. It's actually kind of orange. But I don't have it. Like maybe it'll look good and like subtle when it dries. So we're gonna dry it and see how it looks.

- 07:47-08:02: Looks like a bird. I didn't dry it all the way through. I tried not to make it super straight because my hair is natural right now. I keep thinking Mateo woke up, but it's Ginger walking around. I'm scared.
