Toer in *This Earth of Mankind* in which Minke changes his culture, education, and perception. The background of this research discusses about crisis identity of the main character in a novel *This Earth of Mankind* by Pramoedya A. Toer, United States of America (1996). There are 2 research questions as follow: how is the identity of Minke described in Pramoedya A. Toer on *This Earth of Mankind*? and what are the impacts of Minke's crisis identities in Pramoedya A.
