Penelitian ini dilatarbelakangi oleh pelaksanaan sekolah daring pada pandemi *Covid-19* seperti saat ini, yang mana ini memberikan dampak yang besar bagi pelaksanaan kegiatan belajar mengajar siswa disekolah. Kegiatan belajar mengajar pun dilakukan di dalam rumah masing-masing. Akibat dari adanya pandemi ini membuat orang tua siswa mempunyai persepsi tersendiri dalam menghadapi sekolah daring. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian deskriptif dengan menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif. Penelitian ini dilakukan di wilayah kelurahan Kendangsari dengan subyek penelitian adalah orang tua yang anaknya masih bersekolah SD dan SMP. Dalam penelitian ini digunakan pula teknik analisis data menurut Miles dan Huberman, yaitu *data reduction, data display, dan verification*. Sedangkan untuk Teknik pengambilan datanya menggunakan kuesioner yang dibagikan secara online melalui *Google Form* dan wawancara kepada beberapa orang tua siswa secara langsung. Hasil dari penelitian ini menyebutkan bahwa semua orang tua setuju dengan pelaksanaan sekolah daring saat ini, mengingat angka penyebaran virus *Covid-19* di Indonesia masih terbilang tinggi dan dikhawatirkan jika sekolah tetap dilakukan seperti biasanya akan menimbulkan dampak bagi anak.

This research is motivated by the implementation of online schools in *the Covid-19* pandemic as it is today, which has a big impact on the implementation of teaching and learning activities of students in schools. Teaching and learning activities are also carried out in their homes. As a result of this pandemic, parents have their own perceptions in dealing with online schools. This research is descriptive research using qualitative approach. This research was conducted in Kendangsari village with the research subjects are parents whose children are still in elementary and junior high school. In this study also used data analysis techniques according to Miles and Huberman, namely *data reduction, display data, and verification*. As for data retrieval techniques using questionnaires shared online through *Google Form* and interviews to some parents directly. The results of this study state that all parents agree with the implementation of online schools today, considering the number of *spread of the Covid-19* virus in Indonesia is still quite high and it is feared that if the school continues to be carried out as usual it will have an impact on children.
