CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Study

This is consistent with the findings of Hasan & Hoon's (2012) study, which revealed that podcasts encourage students to learn English and enhance their language abilities, particularly in listening. This potential advantage of podcast was discovered in a study conducted in Saudi Arabia with 46 EFL students (Qasim & Fadda, 2013). The results demonstrated that podcasts were improving students' motivation as well as their listening comprehension, creating a fun environment for learning, and enhancing their automaticity skills, mainly listening. The term "podcast" is a combination of two technologies: "iPod" and "Broadcast". Podcasts are audio recordings of discussions on a particular topic, such as novels, business, politics, health, language, and many more. Podcasts are widely used by the general public to listen to news and knowledge, and to share knowledge that can be repeated. Podcasts are some of the most popular content because you can listen to them anywhere and anvtime.

Unlike radio, where you have to listen to everything broadcast on the radio, podcasts also allow you to select and repeat the topics you need and skip the parts you don't need. In fact, podcasts don't require a radio station, so they can now be used as a low-cost investment vehicle. Listeners can also download themes that suit their tastes. The podcast allows listeners to select and listen to preferred programs that they need. Using podcasts is a great way to improve students' listening skills.
