CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

This chapter consists of background of the study, statement of the problem, objective of the study, significance of the study, and scope and limitation.

A. Background of The Study

Writing is an intellectual activity of finding thoughts and considering the way to express and arrange them into statement and paragraph that is clear to be understood by the people (Komariyah, 2013). The motive of teaching writing as one of the simple language skills is not only to express feelings, thoughts, and beliefs but to facilitate learners' learning, and their daily communication which includes (sending an email, writing a paragraph or a friendly letter), socialization, and the development of academic profession; so writing is some of the most effective tools of communication.
