## CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

#### A. Background of the Study

That's it. English's global position is determined by the number of people who speak it (Lauder, 2008). As a result, English is widely taught and learned as an important language in Indonesia (Panggabean, 2015).

However, to achieve a successful of language program especially English, there are some key points which are very important. The process of teaching and learning the language includes many major components. One of the most important aspects is gender equality. Gender awareness process is very important in the world of education by straightening up several aspects such as curriculum, teaching method, teaching guidelines and textbooks (Otlowski, 2003).

Because textbooks are typically the most prominent element of the curriculum and also the only learning resource used by teachers and students, it is essential to analyze textbooks from a gender perspective. In many parts of the world, textbooks are an effective vehicle for teaching and learning, rather than being used as one potential resource (Loan et al., 2010).

Textbooks also play an important role in society by directly or indirectly conveying social norms, norms, and values (Brugeilles &

Cromer, 2009). They are means of socializing, and representations of the world that can influence students' attitudes and orientations (Craeynest, 2015).

Textbooks also provide access to all kinds of information. Thus transferring the cultural capital of a society to its youngest citizens at a given point in time (Brugeilles & Cromer, 2009b). It is therefore clear that textbooks play a special role in all educational systems, as they are almost the only way for teaching. This makes gender expressions particularly powerful and meaningful (Bursuc, 2015).

Equitable education systems prepare girls and boys alike to be productive and confident citizens. After they go to school, their education must be free of gender stereotypes, prejudices, and discrimination. In many countries, education systems provide examples of curricula and materials that reinforce stereotypes, teachers with biased expectations, and other different means of contributing to gender inequalities that are facilitated by the teaching and learning process (Bursuc, 2015).

Gender equality does not imply that women and men are the same, but that they have equal value and should be accorded equal treatment (Craeynest, 2015). At best, gender equality, especially with respect to access to education, has contributed to the development of the concept of the right to education for all (Brugeilles & Cromer, 2009).

In this study researcher having a scope in gender representation in EFL textbook entitled "BAHASA INGGRIS XII" by Pusat Kurikulum dan Perbukuan, Balitbang, Kemendikbud, Because the EFL textbook from Kurikulum Merdeka not released yet for XII grade of high school, also if we analyze all texts, they fall into genres other than gender analysis, so we only look for gendered images and texts.

In this study, researcher will explore only genre representation of male and female. It covers character, lesson, designation, activities, attributes. The analysis of the text will be discussed based on the concept of gender. Researcher take the Carole Brugeilles and Sylvie Cromer framework because there is the one and only guidelines for analyzing gender representation in EFL Textbook.

## F. Definition of the Key Terms
