Qualitative research methods are descriptive research and tend to use analysis. Process and meaning (subject perspective) are emphasized more in qualitative research. The theoretical basis is used as a guide so that the research focus is in accordance with the facts in the field. In addition, this theoretical basis is also useful for providing an overview of the research background and as material for discussion of research results. There is a fundamental difference between the role of theoretical basis in quantitative research and qualitative research. In quantitative research, research departs from theory to data, and ends in acceptance or rejection of the theory used; whereas in qualitative research the researcher starts from the data, utilizes existing theories as explanatory material, and ends with a theory, for example, such as interviews, observations, and data analysis.

The results of the research and discussion in this thesis are in the form of a description of the motifs of the woven cloth in Ende district, the history and meaning in each of the weaving motifs of the Ende district as well as the tools and materials for making woven fabrics, how to make woven fabrics, and the results of interviews, so that everyone understand and understand how the meaning in each of the woven fabric motifs in Ende district suggestions in this research are to introduce the woven fabric motifs of Ende Regency so that everyone knows about the woven fabrics of East Nusa Tenggara, especially in Ende Regency, and for all weaving craftsmen to continue and maintain the culture of weaving so that it can develop even more and can enrich Indonesian culture.
